Individuals who do not speak English as their primary language and who have a limited ability to read, speak, write or understand English can be limited-English proficient (LEP).

LANGUAGE ASSISTANCE PLAN (LAP)

We have implemented an LAP to help LEP individuals gain access to RMA programs and activities. The LAP identifies language resources, personnel and services for LEP individuals, including employees, USDA agencies, community-based organizations, language translations and interpretation services.
